SUBJECT: VIOLENCE WEEK IN REVIEW OCTOBER 24-30

1. SUMMARY: VIOLENCE WEEK IN EL SALVADOR RETURNED TO THE RELATIVELY LOWER LEVELS THE COUNTRY HAD EXPERIENCED OVER THE PAST TWO MONTHS. REPORTED POLITICAL MURDERS DROPPED TO 71 FROM LAST WEEK'S TOTAL OF 103. THE DEPARTMENT OF AHUACHAPAN MADE THE NEWS FOR THE FIRST TIME IN MONTHS WITH THREE REPORTED POLITICAL MURDERS. VIOLENT INCIDENTS CONTINUED AT AN AVERAGE PACE WITH 27 REPORTED FOR THE WEEK. END OF SUMMARY.

2. DEATHS AND DISSAPPEARANCES: AN APPROXIMATE TOTAL OF 71 PERSONS FELL VICTIM TO POLITICAL MURDER LAST WEEK. THIS WAS A RETURN TO THE LOWER NUMBERS OF DEAD THAT HAVE CHARACTERIZED THE LAST TWO MONTHS. THE PRESS ATTRIBUTED ONE MURDER TO THE SECURITY FORCES, THREE TO RIGHT WING DEATH SQUADS, AND 13 TO LEFTIST TERRORIST. THE REMAINING 54 PERSONS MET DEATH AT THE HANDS

OF UNKNOWN ASSASINS. THE FATE AND ABDUCTORS OF THE 12 PERSONS WHOSE DISSAPERANCE WAS RECORDED ARE ALSO UNKNOWN. FURTHER, THE DEATHS IN ACTION OF 11 SOLDIERS WERE REPORTED BY THE SALVADORAN HIGH COMMAND OR IN NEWS ARTICLES. THE BODIES OF 71 VICTIMS OF POLITICAL MURDER WERE DISCOVERED IN THE FOLLOWING DEPARTMENTS:

C.—ON 10/25 A FIREFIGHT TOOK PLACE NEAR CANTON LAS DELICIAS,  
SAN SALVADOR. CASUALTIES WERE UNREPORTED.

D.—ON 10/25 IN SANTA ANA GUERRILLAS AMBUSHED A MILITARY  
PATROL. THERE WERE NO REPORTS OF CASUALTIES.

E.—ON 10/25 IN CONCHAGUA, LA UNION A FIREFIGHT BETWEEN GOVER-  
NMENT AND GUERRILLA FORCES LEFT AT LEAST ONE CUSTOM POLICEMAN  
DEAD.

F.—ON 10/25 GUERRILLAS HARRASSED MILITARY POST IN SAN MARCOS  
LEMPA, USULUTAN AND SAN NICOLAS LEMPA, SAN VICENTE GUARDING  
THE LEMPA RAILROAD BRIDGE.

G.—ON 10/27 GUERRILLAS ATTACKED THE NATIONAL GUARD POST IN  
PERQUIN, MORAZAN, ONE PASSER-BY WAS WOUNDED.

H.—ON 10/27 IN SANTA ANA TERRORIST ATTACKED A MILITARY PATROL  
ONE SUBVERSIVE DIED IN THE ENCOUNTER AND TWO SOLDIERS AND 6  
YEAR OLD GIRL WERE WOUNDED.

I. ON 10/27 IN SAN SALVADOR A BOMB DESTROYED A PHARMACY AND DAMAGED OTHER NEARBY BUSINESSES.

J. ON 10/27 GUERRILLAS STAGED A 20 MINUTE ATTACK ON THE TOWN OF VILLA VICTORIA, CABANAS. NO CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED, THOUGH THE ATTACKERS REPORTEDLY SHOUTED: "THE GUERRILLA IS WINNING THE REVOLUTION IN THE COUNTRY".

K. ON 10/27 IN THE CAPITAL SUBURB OF MEJICANOS A PRIVATE HOME WAS DAMAGED BY A BOMB.

L. ON 10/27 NEAR NUEVO TEPETITAN, SAN VICENTE GUERRILLAS BURNED MACHINERY AND OTHER EQUIPMENT OF THE "ACAHUAPA" COFFEE PROCESSING PLANT.

M. ON 10/27 NEAR VERAPAZ, SAN VICENTE GUERRILLAS WOUNDED THE "MOLINEROS" COFFEE PROCESSING PLANT TO THE GROUND.

N. ON 10/27 NEAR NUEVO TEPETITAN, SAN VICENTE GUERRILLAS FELLED POWER AND TELEPHONE POLES ACROSS THE HIGHWAY.

O. ON 10/27 NEAR CANTON SAN JACINTO, SAN VICENTE GUERRILLAS AND PATRULLEROS EXCHANGED FIRE. ONE PATRULLERO DIED IN THE EXCHANGE.

P. ON 10/27 GUERRILLAS MADE FURTHER PROBING ATTACKS ON THE DEFENSES OF THE RIO LEMPA RAILROAD BRIDGE IN USULUTAN. THE ATTACKERS REPORTEDLY USED MEGAPHONES TO ANNOUNCE THEIR INTENTION NOT TO REST UNTIL THE BRIDGE WAS DESTROYED.

Q. ON 10/27 HEAVY COMBAT WAS REPORTED ON THE SLOPES OF THE SAN VICENTE VOLCANO. THERE WERE NO REPORTS OF CASUALTIES.

R. ON 10/28 NEAR SUCHITOTO, CUSCATLAN GUERRILLAS AMBUSHED A MILITARY CONVOY LEAVING ONE SOLDIER DEAD AND TWO WOUNDED.

S. ON 10/28 DEFENDING TROOPS REPULSED AN ATTACK ON THE "FIFTH OF NOVEMBER" DAM. IN CHALATENANGO.

T. ON 10/29 A MILITARY CONVOY WAS AMBUSHED BETWEEN CINQUERA AND TEJUTEPEQUE, CABANAS. THREE SOLDIERS WERE REPORTED KILLED AND 13 WOUNDED.

U. ON 10/29 IN SANTA ANA IN QUICK SUCCESSION SHOT OUT THE TIRES OF A NUMBER OF VEHICLES, BURNED A GAS STATION, AND PROVOKED A FIREFIGHT WITH SECURITY FORCES. NO CASUALTIES

V. ON 10/29 NEAR EL TRANSITO, USULUTAN GUERRILLAS ATTACKED AN ELECTRICAL SUBSTATION. TWO SOLDIERS DIED IN THE ATTACK.

W. ON 10/30 NEAR SUCHITOTO, CUSCATLAN, GUERRILLAS BLEW UP A BRIDGE LEADING TO THE TOWN.

X. ON 10/30 NEAR CANTON LAS TABLAS, LA LIBERTAD GUERRILLAS AND TROOPS ENGAGED IN COMBAT. TWO GUERRILLAS WERE KILLED, ONE OF WHOM WAS CARRYING LARGE SUMS OF MEXICAN PESOS AND GUATEMALAN QUETZALES.

Y. ON 10/30 NEAR THE RIO SUMPUL, CHALATENANGO A BATTLE BETWEEN GUERRILLAS AND GOVERNMENT FORCES LEFT UNDETERMINED NUMBER OF GUERRILLAS DEAD.

Z. ON 10/30 NEAR VILLA DOLORES, CABANAS GUERRILLAS FIRED UPON A BUS, KILLING ONE AND WOUNDING 11 OTHERS.

A.A--ON 10/30 NEAR GUALOCOTI, MORAZAN GUERRILLAS AMBUSHED A CIVIL DEFENSE PATROL. THERE WERE REPORT OF CASUALTIES.

4. CREDIT AND BLAME: RADIO VENCEREMOS TOOK NO CREDIT FOR ANY OF THE TERRORIST INCIDENTS REPORTED LAST WEEK, BUT DID CLAIM THESE ADDITIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS.
