1. CONFIDENTIAL ENTIRE TEXT

2. DURING THE WEEKLY MEETING OF THE CIHD ON MARCH 16 IN WHICH THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE PRESIDES, WITH THE L/O IN ATTENDANCE, THE FOLLOWING CASE DEVELOPMENTS WERE DISCUSSED:

SAM SA \$3862 89 OF 87 2387372

WITH A SALVADORAN REQUEST FOR EXTRADITION. THERE WAS
A RECENT INCIDENT INVOLVING ONE OF THE THREE REMAINING
DEFENDANTS IN THE CASE, LT. LOPEZ CIBRIAN. LOPEZ
CIBRIAN HAS A SINUS PROBLEM RESULTING FROM A BULLET;
WOUND; DEFENSE COUNSEL PETITIONED THE COURT TO MOVE
BIN TO THE MILITARY HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT. HE THEN
WAS BEING KEPT IN A MAXIMUM SECURITY PRISON AT SANTA
ANA. THE JUDGE APPROVED THE REQUEST. THE MINISTER OF
JUSTICE, CONCERNED THAT LOPEZ CIBRAIN MIGHT TRY TO
ESCAPE, INSTRUCTED THE DIRECTOR OF THE PRISON NOT TO
COMPLY WITH THE JUDGE'S ORDER. ACCORDING TO BOTH THE
MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE SUPPREME
COURT THE FIGHT OVER THE HOVENENT OF LOPEZ CIBRIAN GOT
HEATED TO THE POINT WHERE THE PRESIDENT OF THE COURT
THREATENED SANTAMARIA WITH A COURT ACTION.

ALTHOUGH LOSING THE FIGHT TO PREVENT INE TRANSFER, INSISTED ON NAVING SECURITY GUARDS PRESENT AT ALL STACES OF THE MOVE. LOPEZ CIBRIAN REHAINS, ACCORDING TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SUPREME COURT, IN MARIONA, A LESS THAM MAXIMUM SECURITY PRISON. SANTAMARIA HOPES TO HAVE THE SIU GATHER ENOUGH EVIDENCE ACAINST NEJIA ANGULO TO PRESS SUPREME COURT PRESIDENT GUTTERREZ CASTRO FOR HIS REMOVAL.

- THE FEMASTRAS ROMBING INVESTIGATION WAS BEEN INACTIVE DUE TO THE LIMITATION OF SIU MUMAN RESOURCES AND THE DEMANDS OF THE JESUIT INVESTIGATION. THE FRI

REPORT COULD NOT IDENTIFY THE MATERIAL USED IN THE BORBING OTHER THAN TO SPECULATE IT WAS A HIGH EXPLOSIVE. FEMASTRAS HAS ASKED THE GOES TO REOPEN THE CASE ALTHOUGH IT IS DOUBTFUL THAT WITH THE PASSAGE OF TIME ANY VIABLE LEADS CAN BE DEVELOPED. UNDERSTANDING HOWEVER, THAT THIS IS A POLITICALLY SENSITIVE CASE.

RIVAS. THE JUDGE IS TAXING DECLARATIONS OF OTHER MEMBERS OF THE 1ST BRIGADE WHO MAY HAVE WORKED WITH JOYA OR HAVE RELEVANT INFORMATION ON HIS ACTIVITIES.
