DEAR SENATOR GRASSLEY:

I AM WRITING IN RESPONSE TO YOUR INQUIRY TO THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE REGARDING THE DISAPPEARANCE OF SALVADORAN CITIZEN JUAN FRANCIS MASSI. MR. YOUR CONSTITUENT, INQUIRED ABOUT THE CASE.

MR. MASSI AND A FRIEND, SARA CRISTIANI CHAN CHAN, WERE LAST SEEN ON AUGUST 19. FRIENDS AND RELATIVES OF THE PAIR ALLEGE THAT THE TWO WERE ARRESTED BY MEMBERS OF THE AIR FORCE. THE AIR FORCE HAS CONSISTENTLY DENIED THAT CHARGE, HOWEVER, AND ALL OTHER SECURITY FORCES HAVE DENIED ANY KNOWLEDGE OF UNCLASSIFIED

EMBASSY OFFICIALS MET WITH MEMBERS OF BOTH FAMILIES
IN EARLY SEPTEMBER, AND WITH MEMBERS OF THE CHAN CHAN
FAMILY SEVERAL TIMES IN OCTOBER. AT THEIR REQUEST,
THE EMBASSY RAISED THE ISSUE OF THE THO
DISAPPEARANCES WITH MILITARY AUTHORITIES, INCLUDING
THE AIR FORCE COMMANDER. AGAIN, MILITARY OFFICIALS
DENIED ANY KNOWLEDGE OF THE CASE. IN OCTOBER,
MEMBERS OF THE CHAN CHAN FAMILY ALLEGED THAT SARA
CRISTINA CHAN CHAN WAS BEING HELD BY THE NATIONAL
POLICE. THE EMBASSY WAS UNABLE, HOWEVER, TO CONFIRM
THIS. TO DATE, NEITHER MS CHAN CHAN NOR MR. MASSI
HAVE REAPPEARED. WE REMAIN IN CONTACT WITH BOTH
FAMILIES, AND ARE PREPARED TO CONTINUE TO ASSIST THEM
WITH ANY FUTURE REQUESTS THEY MIGHT HAVE.

I WISH TO UNDERSCORE THE ADMINISTRATION'S COMMITMENT TO PROGRESS IN FURTHERING RESPECT FOR AND OBSERVANCE OF HUMAN RIGHTS IN EL SALVADOR. THE EVENTS OF THE LAST SEVERAL WEEKS, INCLUDING THE UNPROVOKED FMLM ASSAULT ON THE CAPITAL AND THE EXECUTIONS OF SIX JESUIT PRIESTS AND THO OTHERS AT A LOCAL UNIVERSITY, UNDERSCORE THE NEED FOR GREATER RESPECT FOR HUMAN RIGHTS ON ALL SIDES. THE BUSH ADMINISTRATION CONTINUES TO PRESS THE GOVERNMENT AND MILITARY ON THE ISSUE OF HUMAN RIGHTS AND, MORE RECENTLY, TO ENSURE A FULL AND FAIR INVESTIGATION OF THE JESUIT KILLINGS. RECRIMINATIONS NEED TO BE MADE AGAINST THE FMLN AS WELL, WHICH HAS CLAIMED RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE ASSASSINATIONS OF LOCAL POLITICAL FIGURES, AND VIA ITS RECENT OFFENSIVE CAUSED HUNDREDS OF DEATHS AMONG THE CIVILIAN POPULATION.
